



Family Child Care License

One-Time \$40 Fee Reimbursement

- Fact Sheet -

An unlicensed home-based Care 4 Kids provider who gets their Family Child Care License with the Office of Early Childhood's (OEC) Division of Licensing may get a one-time \$40 reimbursement for their license application. Payment to the provider will be separate from their Care 4 Kids payments.

Who can get the \$40 License Application Fee Reimbursement?

A provider must:

- Have been a Care 4 Kids unlicensed family childcare provider at the time of application for a family child care license to the OEC.
- Have an active family child care license application on file with the OEC on or after July 1, 2013.
- Received a Family Child Care license from OEC.

How to apply for the \$40 License Application Fee Reimbursement?

- Providers meeting the criteria above need to fill out and submit the OEC License Application Fee Reimbursement form to Care 4 Kids.
