PROVIDER DISCONTINUANCE

The provider will be discontinued from the C4K program and is no longer an approved C4K provider. The provider will continue to receive payments until the families' eligibility ends unless the certificate is canceled for other reasons prior to the eligibility end date. Families will be notified when they need to choose a new child care provider.

C4K will no longer continue to monitor your program's compliance. If your program becomes compliant with the Care 4 Kids Health and Safety requirements in the future, a Parent Provider Agreement (PPA) form must be received for each eligible family you provide care for. Once a PPA is received, we will verify your program's compliance.
