Three Months After Suspension	Provider has <i>not</i> met all Health & Safety Requirements:	<ul> <li>Provider becomes Discontinued.</li> <li>A Notice of Provider Discontinuance is mailed.</li> <li>The provider cannot receive Care 4 Kids for new families</li> <li>Existing certificates will remain in effect until the family's renewal</li> <li>Provider will not be checked daily for compliance after becoming Discontinued. The provider must notify Care 4 Kids when requirements have been met to be reactivated.</li> </ul>
