



Family Child Care License Bonus

One-Time \$500 Bonus

- Fact Sheet -

An unlicensed home-based Care 4 Kids provider who gets a Family Child Care License with the Office of Early Childhood's (OEC) Division of Licensing will receive a one-time \$500 bonus after 12 months of service. Payment to the provider will be separate from their Care 4 Kids payments.

Who can get the One-Time \$500 License Bonus?

A provider must:

- Have been a Care 4 Kids unlicensed Family Child Care provider on or after July 1, 2013.
- Received a Family Child Care License from the OEC on or after July 1, 2013. The provider must hold the license in good standing for at least 12 months.
- Have provided 12 cumulative months of Care 4 Kids care. The 12 months can include both when the provider was unlicensed and licensed.

How to apply for the One-Time OEC License Bonus?

- Providers meeting the criteria above need to fill out and submit the OEC One-Time License Bonus Application to Care 4 Kids.
